

## Our Fees

All endodontic treatment carried out is on a private basis.

Please note our fees which will be effective for all referrals received from 1 April 2024.

<p><b>Consultation</b>  <i>(required for all cases to verify the diagnosis and the prognosis and to discuss the treatment options so that an informed treatment choice can be made by the patient)</i></p> <p><i>All treatments start with a consultation or consultation and investigation option</i></p>	<p><b>£125</b></p>  <p><b>Consultation &amp; investigation £250</b></p>
<p><b>Root Canal Treatment</b>  <i>(Including composite core if indicated)</i></p>	<p><b>Non-Molar From £650</b>  <b>Molar From £700</b></p>
<p><b>Root Canal Re-Treatment</b>  <i>(Including composite core if indicated)</i></p>	<p><b>From £700</b>  <b>Molar From £800</b></p>
<p><b>Additional complexity fee</b>  <i>(This is not usually needed but may be applied for cases involving the management of a fractured file, post removal etc.)</i></p>	<p><b>From £100</b>  <i>(discussed with the patient at the consultation appointment on the rare occasions when it is necessary)</i></p>
<p><b>Endodontic surgery/ apicectomy</b></p>	<p><b>From £650</b></p>
<p><b>Full coronal pulpotomy</b></p>	<p><b>From £250</b></p>
<p><b>Dismantle to Evaluate/ internal investigation confirming hopeless prognosis</b>  <i>(rarely, on internal inspection a tooth can be found to be fractured internally and this can lead to extraction of the tooth being advised instead of root canal treatment. In this situation the root canal treatment fee does not apply, but this smaller fee is applied to cover the time and materials involved in establishing this situation)</i></p>	<p><b>From £125</b></p>
